Attention is invited to the reference cited. The Director of Census Operations has brought to notice of Government that, the DEOs have drafted Teachers / Enumerators for Teachers Training Programme, despite a serious concern expressed by the Director that the Census work would be hampered by doing so.

2. The Census work is a statutory duty to be performed under the Census Act,1948 and Census Rules,1993. Teachers / Enumerators drafted for Census work cannot neglect their Census duties. It is reported that as on date 15-25% of the Enumeration work is left undone, because of shortage of Schedules. The first phase of Census work will be completed by 10th June, 2010. Under no circumstances should any Teacher / Enumerator leave their statutory Census duties incomplete.

3. All District Collectors and Commissioners of Municipal Corporations who are the Principal Census Officers should strictly comply with instructions and give top-most priority to completing the Census work by 10.6.2010 positively.

4. Any deviation in this regard will be viewed seriously.
